In order to maintain high quality camp programs, we have established a minimum and maximum number of campers needed per camp. The YMCA reserves the right to cancel a program due to insufficient enrollment.

#### **DEPOSITS**

Deposits are required to reserve a space and are due at time of registration. Deposits are non-refundable and non-transferable.

- Specialty Camps \$15/week/camper
- Camp Daybreak \$5/day/camper

#### **TRANSFERS & REFUNDS**

If your plans change and you need to transfer to a different session, we will be glad to accommodate you if a new session is available. Please note the following policies:

- Transfers must be requested in writing at least (1) one week prior to the beginning of the camp session.
- Deposits are non-transferable
- There will be no retroactive transfers of payments.
