## POST-CAMP

4:00-6:00PM

\$32/week

Post-camp provides working families the flexibility and convenience to accommodate busy schedules. Campers will end their day with engaging activities including, board games, reading, sports & games and socializing with friends. Most activities will be enjoyed outside.

# IMPORTANT DETAILS

## CAMP WEEKS

Both Camp Minogi and Camp Daybreak will run for 10 weeks.

Camp starts June 20th, 2022 and runs through August 26th, 2022. We will not have camp Monday, July 4th due to the holiday.

## MEALS INCLUDED

In partnership with the Public Schools of Petoskey, all campers will have access to FREE breakfast, lunch and snack every day. Campers may take part in one or all of these offerings without any reservations or paperwork. Please make sure to inform the Y office of any food allergies so we can make sure your camper stays safe and healthy.

## FIELD TRIPS

Campers go on exciting field trips every week. To keep them safe, they must wear their YMCA shirts on all field trip days. Your camper will receive a shirt on the first day of camp. Camp Minogi goes to the beach every Tuesday and Thursday and a field trip every Wednesday. Camp Daybreak has the opportunity for walking trips each day, so they must have their YMCA shirt with them each day.



# IMPORTANT DETAILS

## REGISTRATION

### CAMPER HEALTH INFORMATION

All camper health history and medical release forms are required for registration. Incomplete registrations will not reserve your place at camp. Due to Michigan state regulations, a copy of your child's immunization records are also required. To best serve your child, please inform our staff of any allergies or special health conditions that may exist.

### PROGRAM CANCELLATION

In order to maintain high quality camp programs, we have established a minimum and maximum number of campers needed per camp. The YMCA reserves the right to cancel a program due to insufficient enrollment.

## PAYMENT

### DEPOSITS

A deposit of \$15 per child, per week (Minogi) or \$5 per child, per day (Daybreak) is required to reserve a space and are due at time of registration. Deposits are non-refundable.

### TRANSFERS & REFUNDS

We do not offer transferring of days due to our limited number of spots available. You are able to cancel days and register for a different day if those spots are available. Refunds are available if notice is given in writing two weeks before the Monday of the week you are looking to cancel. If notice is not given, there will be a cancellation fee. See parent handbook for more info on refunds.

### FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

Families may apply for financial assistance for programs such as day camp, youth sports and enrichment. We make financial assistance available to those in need. Awards are based on a number of factors including total household income and number of dependents in the household. The process is confidential and the application forms are available at the Y office or online at [ymcanm.org](http://ymcanm.org)

## DROP OFF PICK UP

All parents or authorized pick-ups are required to sign campers in and out when dropping off or picking up.

If attending Camp Minogi, campers should be dropped off between 8:00am-8:15am and picked up between 3:50am-4:00pm.

If attending Camp Daybreak, campers should be dropped off between 7:00am-7:15am and picked up between 5:50pm - 6:00pm.
