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ABOUT THE CHAMPIONSHIP

This meet is a sanctioned, closed, inter-association championship YMCA meet. This meet and all participants will adhere to the Rules that Govern YMCA Competitive Sports and the Swimming Addendum to the Rules that Govern YMCA Competitive Sports. USA Swimming technical rules will be followed. The meet is YMCA sanctioned and approved by the Watertown YMCA Blue Sharks of USA Swimming.

MEET FORMAT WAIVER

RESERVE THE RIGHT TO MAKE CHANGES: The host organization reserves the right to make any adjustments to the provisions of the meet announcement deemed necessary to ensure the fair and efficient running of the meet. Changes will be communicated as far in advance as possible. None of the required elements of a sanctioned meet may be changed.

LOCATION AND FACILITY

The Watertown YMCA is configured as a 6 lane, SCY course. Water depth at start is 9 feet (minimum 5 feet required) and at turn end is 3 feet 6 inches. Colorado electronic timing system will be used. The competition course has been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C (4)

There is a small rec pool and play area that will be closed both days.

There is spectator seating for 150 people. Areas outside the pool are available for families to relax.

Swimmers are expected to stay in the Tennis court gym. Absolutely no glass bottles are allowed anywhere in the facility.

Inclement Weather/Cancelation: We will make every effort to inform each team if there is a change in the meet schedule due to inclement weather.



ELIGIBILITY

ATHLETE

YMCA Membership: An athlete must be a YMCA member in good standing who holds an annual, full privilege membership at the YMCA.

Amateur Status: An athlete may not have represented a college, university or other post-high school institution in any competition and may not have accepted pay or compensation for competing as a swimmer.

Unattached Athletes: There is no unattached status in YMCA Swimming.

Age: Age is determined as of your age on December 1, 2023

YMCA Meet Participation: Be a current full privileged YMCA member for the team you are representing.

Athletes with a Disability: Swimmers with a disability are welcome to enter this meet. The coach or team entry person must alert the meet director and the meet referee as to the need for any special accommodations or seeding arrangements at the time the entry is submitted. If modifications to USA Swimming rules are necessary, then the coach or athlete must notify the meet referee of any disability prior to competition.

Required Certifications: Coaches must hold current certifications in the following courses in order to receive a deck credential: Professional Rescuer CPR, First Aid, Safety Training for Swim Coaches (a Lifeguard certification may be used if accompanied by completion of the Safety Training for Swim Coaches online content), Principles of YMCA Competitive Swimming and Diving and Athlete Protection Training. A list of the acceptable certifications can be found in the Swimming Addendum to the Rules That Govern Competitive Sport.

Coach Registration: Each coach must have completed the annual YMCA on-line team and coach registration process. Coaches who are not registered and approved will not be permitted on deck.

Teams without A Coach at the Meet: All athletes and teams must have at least one certified and credentialed YMCA coach designated as being responsible for their supervision during competition. When a YMCA team



will not have a coach present, that YMCA may authorize an eligible coach from another YMCA attending the meet to be responsible for their athletes at the meet. The Meet Director and Meet Referee must be notified of this situation.

TEAM

Team Registration: Each team must have completed the annual YMCA on-line team registration and paid the annual registration fee.

Insurance: Each team that participates in the meet must have a current and correct Certificate of Liability Insurance, in effect through the last day of the meet.

ENTRY INFORMATION

ENTRY LIMITS:

- 1. USA-S Rules will be followed.
- 2. An individual may enter no more than 3 individual events and 2 relays. If open relays are swum, they do not count toward the event limit.
- *3.* There are no restrictions on the number of entries per team in individual events.
- 4. There is no limitation to the number of relays a team may enter in a relay event. ONLY A relays will be scored.
- 5. Swimmers may swim 'up' 2 years in a relay. i.e. a 13 yr old swimmer may swim on a 15 and up relay.
- 6. NO swimmers will be allowed in the stands with their suits on.
- 7. Deck changes are prohibited.
- 8. Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms.

QUALIFICATION PERIOD: The qualification period is September 1, 2023 through the entry deadline of January 15, 2024.

TIMES: No Times (NT) are not allowed. Submit entry times in actual time of short course yards. Entered times must be the swimmer's BEST time achieved during the qualifying period.

USA-S IDs: Only USA-S registered athletes should have an ID number in the Meet Entry File.



ENTRY FEES: \$5.00 per individual event \$20.00 per relay event (\$5.00 per swimmer) \$8.00 deck fee (one-time fee per swimmer) OTHER: Programs will be available for sale.

ENTRY DEADLINE: January 15, 2024

ENTRY PROCEDURE: Entries are to be submitted electronically. An event file will be provided. Please email entries to Sarah Weir at <u>watbluesharks@gmail.com</u>. Please contact Sarah Weir (meet manager) if you do not receive confirmation within 24 hours.

PAYMENT: Please submit checks to the Watertown YMCA Blue Sharks postmarked by January 19, 2024.

VOLUNTEERS/OFFICIALS/TIMERS

OFFICIALS AND TIMERS: Teams are **REQUIRED** to provide **(2) timers per session for timing assignments**. Each team will provide 2 officials and 2 timers for the morning and afternoon of each day. Please email Mackenzie Dickinson at <u>mknzdickinson@gmail.com</u> with the officials that would like to participate.We will require names be provided prior to the meet so that we do not have to hold up the meet looking for timers. Coaches are asked to ensure coverage as noted on the schedule to expedite the meet.

CHECK-IN PROCEDURE

MEET CHECK-IN PROCEDURE: Head coaches should check-in at the coaches room.

EVENT CHECK-IN: There will be a positive check-in for the 1000 free.

COACHES MEETING/SCRATCH MEETING: Coaches meeting will be announced prior to each session. Please provide courtesy scratches to the meet manager.

OFFICIALS AND TIMERS MEETING: Officials and timers meeting will be announced at the meet prior to each session.



PROCEDURES AND OPERATIONS

RULES: The meet will run under YMCA Rules that Govern Competitive Sports, Addendum to the YMCA Rules that Govern Competitive Sports, CNY Swim League, USA-S Technical Rules.

MEET FORMAT: The meet will be swum using a Timed finals format.

Swimmer's age will be determined as of **December 1, 2023.**

EVENT SEEDING: Events will be seeded Slowest to Fastest. The Meet Referee/Administrative Official reserves the right to combine heats.

SCRATCH PROCEDURES: An athlete is considered entered into an event unless

he/she scratches from that event. If an athlete does not scratch from an event and does not swim the event, that event still counts toward the athlete's total number of events for the meet.

DECLARED FALSE START: An athlete may also withdraw from a heat or swim-off by electing to take a declared false start. Such declaration must be made known to the Deck Referee before the heat or swim off is announced. A declared false start counts as an event swum for the athlete and will be counted in the maximum number of events allowed for each athlete.

WARM-UP SAFETY PROCEDURES: Teams **will** be assigned lanes for warm ups. During designated warm up sessions, athletes may only enter the competition pools feet first. The exception is during specific warm up periods when sprint lanes are designated for practicing racing starts.

Bull Pen: 10 & under swimmers and 11 & up will be bull penned in the Tennis Court Gym

STARTS: 'Fly-over' starts **will** be used at this meet. All swimmers (except for Backstroke starts) should remain in the water at the completion of their race until the next heat has begun.

Protests against the judgment decisions of starters, stroke, turn, place and relay take-off judges can only be considered by the Referee and the Referee's decisions will be final USA-S Rule 102.23).

CONDUCT AND RESTRICTIONS: The Meet Referee reserves the right to dismiss any swimmer, coach and/or spectator from the competition due to inappropriate conduct.



- Deck access is limited to only registered and approved coaches, swimmers, and working officials.
- Deck changes are prohibited.
- Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open-ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.
- Glass containers are not permitted on deck. All garbage is the responsibility of each individual team. The team areas shall be cleared after each session by the team utilizing the area.
- The use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms.
- Massage tables are not permitted.
- Individuals are responsible for the security of their personal belongings and are encouraged not to bring valuables to the meet venue and not to leave items unattended.
- Swimmers are not permitted in the spectator stands between events.
- Folding chairs are not allowed on the pool deck.

Awards and Recognition

SCORING: Individual Events 1st-12th place:

AWARDS: First through twelfth place for all events will receive awards. All awards can be picked up in the Coaches/Officials Room for all participating teams.

ADMISSION FEE: None

HEAT SHEETS/PROGRAMS: Available for sale

CONCESSION STAND: There will be a concession stand in the lobby at the meet.

T-SHIRTS: Pre-order sales ONLY. An online link will be sent to each team.

ATHLETE APPAREL: Swimmers must wear shirts and footwear outside the pool deck.

HANDICAP SEATING: will be available



CONDUCT AND RESTRICTIONS:

- No Flash Photography at the start of competition races.
- No personal chairs are allowed in the spectator area unless for handicap accessibility
- Parents are responsible for the conduct of their children. Children are not allowed to roam the facility unattended.
- The use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms.
- Spectators are not permitted on deck. Permission is granted via Meet Director for handicap accessibility.
- No smoking, drugs, or alcohol are permitted in the swimming complex.
- Deck access is restricted to USA Swimming athletes, coaches, officials and meet volunteers. All non-athlete members must have proof of registration or a credential while on deck and present them upon meet management request.

LIABILITY, SAFETY AND EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

INSURANCE: Each Association participating in this meet must have insurance coverage for representative(s) including leadership and participants who will be in attendance for the period of travel from their Association to the meet, during the entire period of the meet and return to their Association. Appendix 2 must be signed by each association participating in the meet.

LIABILITY LIMITS:

- In granting this approval, it is understood and agreed that USA Swimming shall be free and held harmless from any liabilities or claims for damages arising by reason of injuries to anyone during the conduct of the meet.
- In granting the YMCA Sanctioning, it is understood and agreed that YMCA of the USA shall be free and held harmless from any liabilities or claims for damages arising by reason of injuries to anyone during the conduct of the meet.

EMERGENCIES: the facility personnel will handle all emergencies at the meet. These individuals will provide CPR and first aid as needed and will ensure that individuals with serious injuries are transported immediately to the nearest hospital for further treatment. Defibrillators will be on site.

Any coach, athlete or official who recognizes an emergency situation should immediately inform the facility's personnel and then make sure the vicinity of the emergency is clear for the emergency personnel to do their job.



UNACCOMPANIED ATHLETE: Each athlete must have a certified coach responsible for him/her while on the pool deck. The coach of the athlete must authorize in writing a coach from another team to represent their team and be responsible for the swimmer(s).

CONCUSSION AWARENESS: This meet will follow the YMCA of USA Concussion procedure. Anyone who observes or has knowledge of a potential head injury should immediately notify lifeguards and/or hired medical personnel. Once the injury report is completed, the lifeguard and/ or hired medical personnel will notify the Event Staff, the athlete's coaching staff, and the Meet Director.

If a head injury occurs, the action plan below will be followed:

- 1. Athlete is removed immediately from participation by the Meet Director
- 2. Athlete must be evaluated by a licensed healthcare professional experienced in identifying and treating concussions. In addition, the athlete must be in compliance with the laws that are in effect within the jurisdiction where the meet is held.
- 3. The coaching staff will inform the athlete's parents or guardians about the possible concussion and give or send them the fact sheet on concussion.
- 4. The athlete will not be allowed back to warm-up or compete until a healthcare professional, experienced in evaluating concussions, determines that the athlete is symptom-free and is OK to return to participation.

LIGHTNING POLICY: The National Lightning Safety Institute, National Athletic Trainers Association, American College of Emergency Physicians, USA Swimming, and YMCA of the USA all recommend or require closing an indoor pool during an electrical storm. This policy will be followed at the meet.

EVACUATION PROCEDURE: Will be announced before each session

PARKING:

IMPORTANT PARKING INFORMATION AND NOTICE

Parking is available in the surrounding parking lot of the Watertown Family YMCA. Parking is allowed in marked parking spaces only. Marked street parking is also available.

DO NOT PARK ALONG ROADWAY, IN DRIVE AREAS, ON GRASS OR ANY LOCATION NOT DESIGNATED A PARKING SPACE. ALL ROADWAYS AND DRIVE AREAS MUST REMAIN OPEN AND CLEAR FOR EMERGENCY ACCESS.

<u>SATURDAY ONLY</u>: No parking is available at the North Country Family Health Center.
