Applications are available at the Welcome Center or online. YMCA is committed to protecting the privacy of its members and maintaining their personal information in confidence.

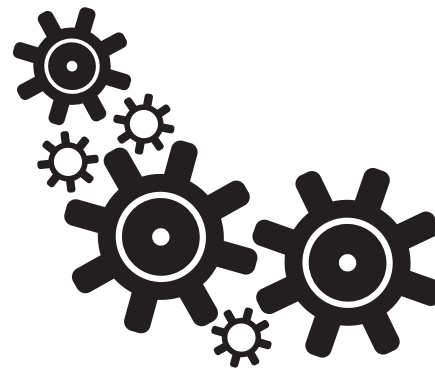
