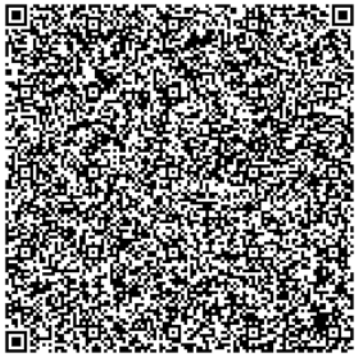

A RSPA & DUPR certified coach will be on site to provide free DUPR ratings, helping players measure and track their progress. Courts will be divided by level of play and then transition into DUPR rating courts, ensuring fair and engaging matchups for everyone.

Players are strongly encouraged to receive their free DUPR rating, with guidance and explanation provided by the coach throughout the session.
