Blood Pressure Self-Monitoring Program Grant

The Corona-Norco Family YMCA is so excited to announce that our Y has been awarded a **Blood Pressure Self-Monitoring Program Grant,** through a national alliance with the <u>Centers</u> for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and the <u>YMCA of the USA</u>.

Approximately one third of the U.S. adult population (33%) have high blood pressure, or hypertension. High blood pressure rates are even higher in African American and Mexican American populations. High blood pressure increases the risk for heart attack, stroke, heart failure, and kidney disease, but only half of those with high blood pressure have their condition under control. Studies have shown that routine self-monitoring of blood pressure leads to better blood pressure management. If you are experiencing High Blood Pressure, this program might be for you. 
