### **AQUATICS SPOTLIGHT**

We launched our swim lesson program in May of 2022 in partnership with the City of Corona. To date we celebrate the following highlights: 1201 total swimmers, 735 of which were funded by First 5 of Riverside County. We also certified 10 new Lifeguards and 13 new Swim Instructors

Our YMCA swim lessons prepare children of all ages to become water safe through developing their skills and confidence. Each lesson focuses on specific skills. Lessons are progressive, building on previously learned skills. Swimmers are able to perform each skill comfortably and consistently before progressing to the next Stage of lessons. The YMCA offers year-round lessons for ages 6-month old to adult, and beginners to competitive swimmers.
