WHAT IS PROVIDED IN MY REGISTRATION FEE?

MEMBERS - \$90, COMMUNITY - \$125

The YMCA is committed to providing the highest quality program for you and your family. Staff is provided to oversee all operations of practices and games. Referees are trained in rules and regulations of soccer. Fields are maintained and kept in safe and presentable conditions. Additionally, your child will be provided with a team jersey. Every child will receive an end of the season medal. Eight games are scheduled.

DOES THE YMCA GUARANTEE MY REQUESTS?

The YMCA cannot guarantee any requests that are made for days, times, coaches, etc. We try our hardest to accommodate all requests.

WHAT AGE GROUP SHOULD MY CHILD BE IN?

Your child should be in an age group based on their birth date. The first day of practice, February 26th, is the deadline for an age group (e.g. a 7 year old that turns 8 before the first day of practices would have to play in the 8/9 age group)

WILL THE YMCA COMMUNICATE INFORMATION WITH ME?

Yes, the primary forms of communication are through email & PlayerSpace. The YMCA will communicate practice schedules, game schedules, and other important information throughout the season via PlayerSpace. Please add the @ymcagreenville.org & @playerspace.com domains to your safe sender list so emails do not go to your junk folder.

WHAT IS PLAYERSPACE?

Playerspace is a tool that the Y uses to keep parents and coaches informed. This program will enhance your experience and keep you informed throughout the season. You can message your coach & fellow parents, sync your game schedule to your phone, post pictures, etc.

WHEN SHOULD I HEAR FROM THE COACH?

Coaches are expected to review their rosters and contact their players the week of February 19th, after the coaches meeting. Please contact Michael Shealy, Sports Director at michael.shealy@ymcagreenville.org if you have not heard from your coach by one week before practices start.

PRACTICE INFORMATION

Practices begin the week of February 26th

- Age 3 will practice from 5:30 6:00 and play their game from 6:00 6:30 on Mondays.
- Ages 4 & 5 as well as ages 6 & 7 will have practice once per week at 5:30pm Monday-Friday.
- Practices for ages 8-14 will be twice per week and will begin at 5:30* or 6:45* Monday-Friday.
 - Coaches will choose the practice days/times for the team they coach. *Practice times are subject to change prior to the start of the season.

WHEN WILL THE GAMES BE PLAYED?

- Age 3 will have games on the same day and time of their scheduled practices, after completing one week of practice.
- Ages 4-5 will have games on Saturdays from 9:00am-3:00pm on fields 4A 4E at Caine Halter.
- Ages 6-7 will have games on Saturdays from 9:00am-3:00pm on fields 2A 2D at Caine Halter.
- Ages 8-14 will have games on Saturdays from 9:00am-4:00pm. Games will be at Caine Halter and/or any of the other YMCA of Greenville branches.
 - We will have one or two weeknight games during the season

WHAT ABOUT INCLEMENT WEATHER AND CANCELLATIONS?

- Practices- the Sports Director will call practices under severe weather (lighting, thunder storms, tornado watch), ongoing hard rain, snow/ice, fields unplayable, and/or any possible weather threats. Otherwise, any other weather conditions such as small rain showers will be at the discretion of the coach. This is for all ages. Please get a contact list of the Head Coach, Assistant Coach, and Team parent to see if practice is called off. If the YMCA does call practices, the decision will be made by 4:30pm. Always check with your coach to see if it's cancelled.
- Games- the <u>Sports Director will call games</u> at the earliest time possible. The Sports Director will call or email all coaches
 as soon as a decision is made. <u>This decision will be made by 4:30pm for weekdays and 8:00am on Saturdays.</u> After this
 time, all decisions will be made on the field and information will be given to the Member Services desk at the YMCA.
 Always check with your coach to see if it's cancelled.

WHAT DO I NEED TO KNOW ABOUT TEAM AND INDIVIDUAL PICTURES?

After the game schedule has been created, we will send it to the photographer and he will develop a picture schedule. As soon as we get this, we will pass it along to coaches and parents through email. PortraitEFX is the photography company. IS THERE AN END OF SEASON PARTY?

Medals will be given to coaches before the end of the season. It is up to coaches to pass them out after the last game or at a party. If you would like your team to have a party to pass out medals, make arrangements with your coach and/or team parent to help set one up.
