

## RECESS CELEBRATES 10TH ANNIVERSARY

For adults with diverse abilities, post-high school life may be a huge unknown for themselves and their caregivers with opportunities limited or hard to find. The YMCA of Greenville's signature program for Recreation, Education, Community, Exercise, and Social Service illuminates the options for these families. RECESS has grown from a small network to serve 73 ongoing participants – providing them weekly programming for continued growth, connection, and fun.
