### **ENHANCE FITNESS AT THE Y**

EnhanceFitness is an evidence–based group exercise and falls prevention program that helps older adults at all levels of fitness become more active, energized and empowered. The 16-week program meets 3 times per week for 1 hour of fun with a focus on dynamic cardiovascular exercise, strength training, balance, and flexibility.

EnhanceFitness is currently funded by a federal grant from the Administration for Community Living as part of the Florida Falls Prevention project. There is no cost to participate and it is open to members and non-members. Classes start October 24th at the Boynton Y and the next session starts in January 2023 at the Boca Y.
