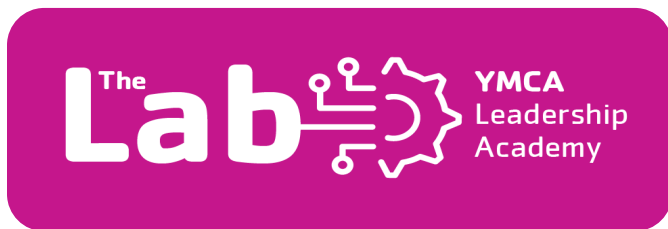

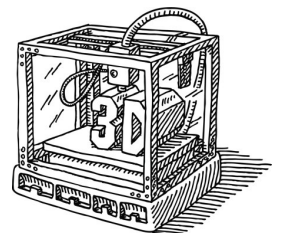


3D Printing Club
