Our teen leadership camp is designed for mature and enthusiastic teens who are interested in developing skills and working with children. In addition, LITs make friends and experience camp from a new perspective, as many of our LITs become camp counselors subsequently. LIT applications must be fully completed and returned to the Peter Blum Family YMCA or emailed to jrodriguez@ymcaspbfc.org. Any incomplete applications will not be contacted. Potential LIT's must be the ones to complete their application for it to be considered.

Being involved with our day camp program is a privilege and a serious obligation. Not only will you take control of your own experience, but also that of campers with whom you interact. You are expected to live up to the expectations of the program, which are as follows:

- Cell phones are strictly prohibited at camp. Texting and using cell phones while supervising children can be compared to texting and driving and is very dangerous and unacceptable. All cell phones if seen will be confiscated immediately.
- Take responsibility for your own actions and learning as well as those of your assigned group.
- Present yourself as a role model for children at all times.
- Approach each day with fresh energy and view challenges as learning opportunities.
- Respect each member of the Peter Blum Family YMCA community, staff, campers, and fellow LIT's. Keeping all hands, feet and other items to myself at all times.
- Have appropriate and healthy conversations at all times (never using inappropriate language).
- Responsible for being on time every day and notifying Supervisor when going to be late or absent. LIT's must commit Monday-Friday 8am-5:00pm. (Session 1 Dates: 6/3-7/3 & Session 2 Dates: 7/8-8/7)
- ****LIT's will not be permitted to leave earlier than 5:00 pm unless approved by the supervisor, no exceptions****
- Stay with your group at all times, unless instructed by my supervisor.
- Not engage in any inappropriate relationships with ant other LIT or staff.
- Always wear YMCA-appropriate attire. (PPE MASK, LIT shirt, khaki fingertip length shorts, closed-toe shoes).
- Take your position at the Peter Blum Family YMCA seriously and perform to the best of your ability
