Our YMCA of South Palm Beach County's 2024 Annual Giving Campaign goal is \$1,200,000! All funds raised in the Annual Giving Campaign go back to financial assistance.

These funds broken down can help our community by:

- \$50- Pays for one child to stay active and healthy by participating in Fit Kids Youth Fitness program for one month.
- \$150- Allows one special needs child the ability to learn life-saving water safety swim skills by providing one-on-one lessons.
- \$250- Provides a month of after school care filled with learning opportunities and positive role models for a deserving child.
- \$500- Scholarships a teen with a one-year membership to the YMCA, providing a place for belonging, friendship, and achievement.

- \$1,200- Provides a preschool classroom, who otherwise would not have access to a pool, life-saving lessons in community pools within their neighborhood.
- \$5,000- Sponsors 12 cancer survivors in 24 sessions of Live Strong at the YMCA for participants to experience improved fitness and quality of life.

SUPPORTING VITAL PROGRAMS FOR PARKINSON'S DISEASE

For many older adults living with Parkinson's disease, maintaining an active lifestyle is crucial to managing symptoms, improving quality of life, and fostering a sense of community. The disease, which primarily affects adults over the age of 60, presents unique challenges, including mobility limitations, balance issues, and decreased muscle strength. In response, our YMCA of South Palm Beach County offers a variety of specialized programs designed to help participants manage, maintain, and even prevent symptoms associated with

Parkinson's such as *Parkinson's Surf & Turf, Parkinson's Cycle,* and *Parkinson's Dance.*These programs provide participants the opportunity for exercise that enhance their physical health, emotional well-being, and social connection.

Our YMCA is proud to announce that we have received a generous \$10,000 grant from Boca Regional Hospital Foundation to support Parkinson's programming. Without external funding, these programs are extremely difficult to offer to the

community at no cost to participants. This grant will help ensure that participants can continue to benefit from these programs, empowering them to manage their symptoms and maintain their independence.

Margaret, along with her husband Robert, Board of Trustee Members, Branch Board members, and friends all came together for a blessing of the bus. Food trucks were available for all to enjoy, followed by a special trip in the new bus to get ice cream.





During the blessing provided by Margaret, those in attendance left impactful notes on magnetic flowers and were added to the outside of the bus. Some notes included, "You are loved.", "Life is a ride, enjoy it." and "Lead for a better tomorrow". These flowers have been moved to the inside for the children riding the bus to read.

"At the Y and as with me, we make it fun," said Margaret. "I'm so happy that I was able to provide the muchneeded bus. It certainly affirms the Y's presence in our community."

These buses will serve as transportation from local elementary and middle schools to the Y for afterschool care, and will also be used throughout the summer for camp field trips.
