## \$20,000 DONATION EXPANDS YMCA TEEN SCHOLARSHIPS FOR UNDERSERVED YOUTH

This critical funding will provide full and partial financial scholarships, giving teens access to YMCA memberships and programs that promote academic success, leadership, and personal growth.

Each year, the Y serves over 1,800 teens through THE LAB: YMCA Leadership Academy at the Peter Blum Family YMCA—an inclusive space for leadership training, college and career readiness, and social-emotional development. Programs include summer camp, afterschool enrichment, robotics, art, sports, and more.
