The YMCA of South Palm Beach County served **41,771** INDIVIDUALS in 2024.



7,683 youth and teens created memories at **Y CAMPS**.

107,399 HOURS OF PHYSICAL ACTIVITY were completed through our Y's Summer Camp.

3,319 youth participated in **AFTER SCHOOL** programs at the Y and **9,686** youth participated in **AFTER SCHOOL** programs through our partnership with Prime Time Palm Beach County.

Over 50K HOURS OF HOMEWORK HELP AND LITERACY HOURS were completed in our Education Enrichment Program.

5,178 children and teens participated in our **YOUTH SPORTS PROGRAMS**.

399 individuals donated their time **VOLUNTEERING** for the Y.



9,718 participated in **SWIM LESSONS** and **3,548** in **LAND-BASED WATER SAFETY** education.

9,661 at risk youth received **WATER SAFETY EDUCATION AND SWIM INSTRUCTION**.

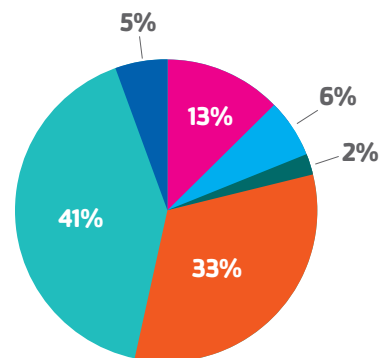

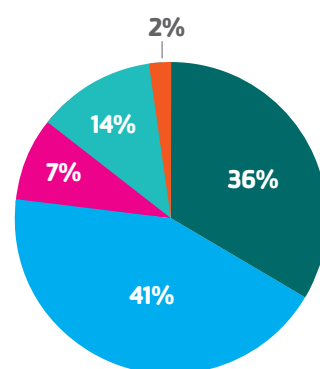
